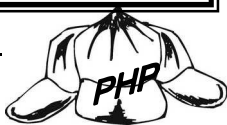
April Calendar

Hats Off to PHP!

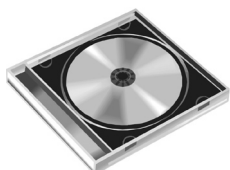
